

Under this agreement for 2014 Mount Isa School of the Air will receive

This funding will be used to

- Target at risk students (students below NMS and at NMS) to meet the NMS across all domains by 2015.
- Students with an identified learning difficulty will achieve their individual learning goals in reading and numeracy from their current level to 100%.
- Improve the percentage of children in Years 3, 5 & 7 achieving school targets in the upper two bands from 4/15 domains to 8/15 domains (improvement in 2014 achieved 2015).
- A target of 30% of students in Year 9 to achieve in the U2B.

Our strategy will be to

- A process in place to identify at risk students and analysis of NAPLAN data and short term data cycles and to give them individual "boost" lessons.
- A set of data collection tools and timelines are implemented across the school.
- Implementing the Early Start Data in the context of Distance Education.(P-2)
- Ensure the intent of GRG guarantee are a clear part of performance framework discussions.
- Individualising student goals and learning through individual reading and feedback sessions.
- Provide coaching and professional development in the developed framework for all staff.

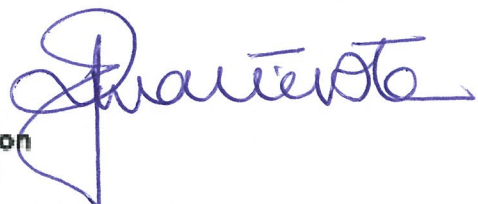
Our school will improve student outcomes by
